Annual meeting of GAAC's Advisory Board

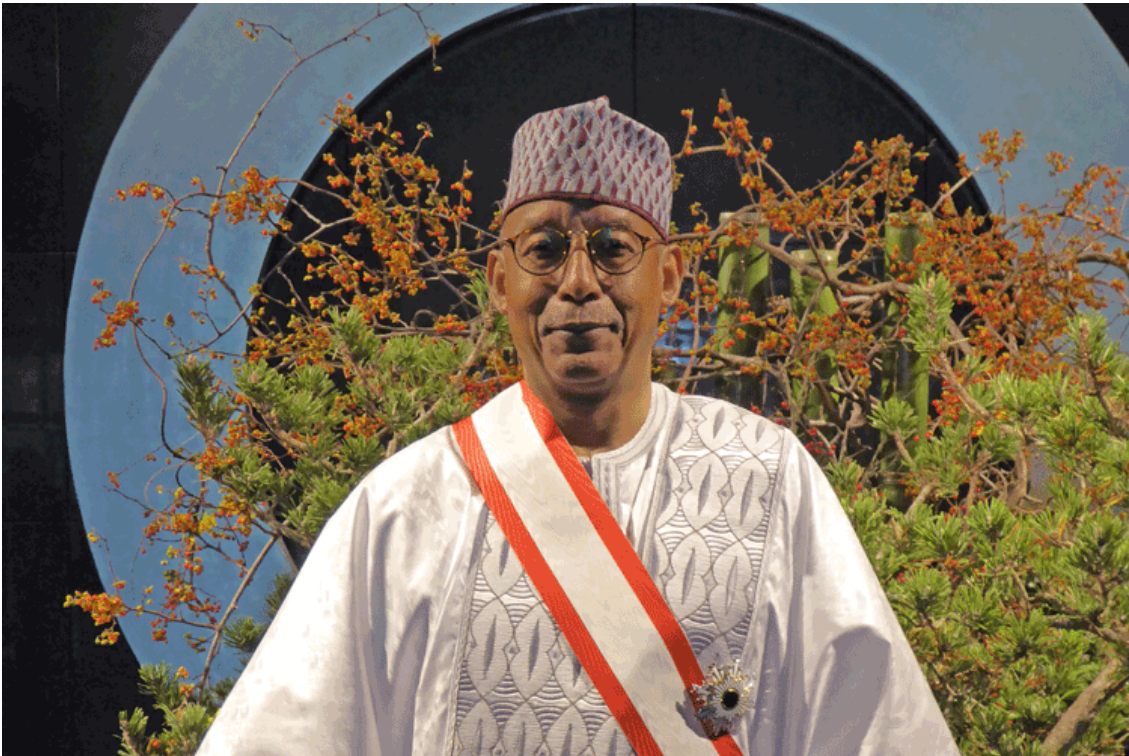


The annual Global Alliance Against Cholera Advisory Council Roundtable Discussion was held on Tuesday, September 24, 2019, in Washington, DC. The meeting provided the opportunity to present and discuss some of the latest advances in WASH (water, sanitation and hygiene) to control and prevent cholera.

Progress in the fight against cholera fuelled the last meeting of the Global Alliance Against Cholera Advisory Board. On Tuesday, September 24, at the Cosmos Club in Washington, DC, USA, new approaches to urban outbreak control, models to predict cholera outbreaks, and initiatives to prevent water-related diseases were discussed. 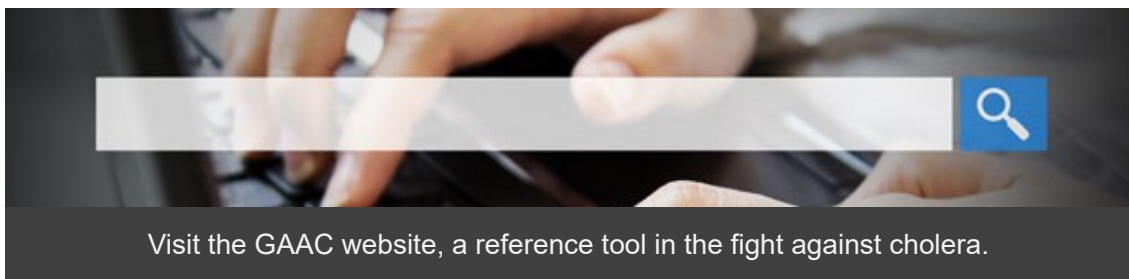
